below and those applicable to my business are marked with a ( ✓ ).

- \_\_\_\_\_ Provide demonstration gardens, perennial/annual displays,
- \_\_\_\_\_ Open to the public seasonally a minimum of 5 days/week, 6 hours each day.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Located within 15 kilometers of the highway exit that best services the facility.

It is my understanding that if you approve our grower facility for signage, NS Department of Public Works  
staff will install a sign(s) at the appropriate exit(s), and another sign at the end of the off ramp with a  
directional sign. I understand that I am responsible for signage, directing visitors from the off-ramp to my  
location of business. I am aware that I need to check with the municipal government regarding signage  
rules and regulations on secondary roads.
